
Guarda-Rios (Kingfisher) is a collective bird. A family of small to medium-sized, brightly colored birds, who watch over the memories of the waters and sings them, so that they fly.

After years of improvising and experimenting together in other bigger vocal ensembles, Mariana Camacho, Susana Nunes and João Neves give voice to this collective. Departing from traditional Portuguese repertoire, the trio builds bridges between old folk songs and free improvisation, offering a new perspective over a repertoire otherwise going extinct through acapella improvised arrangements.
