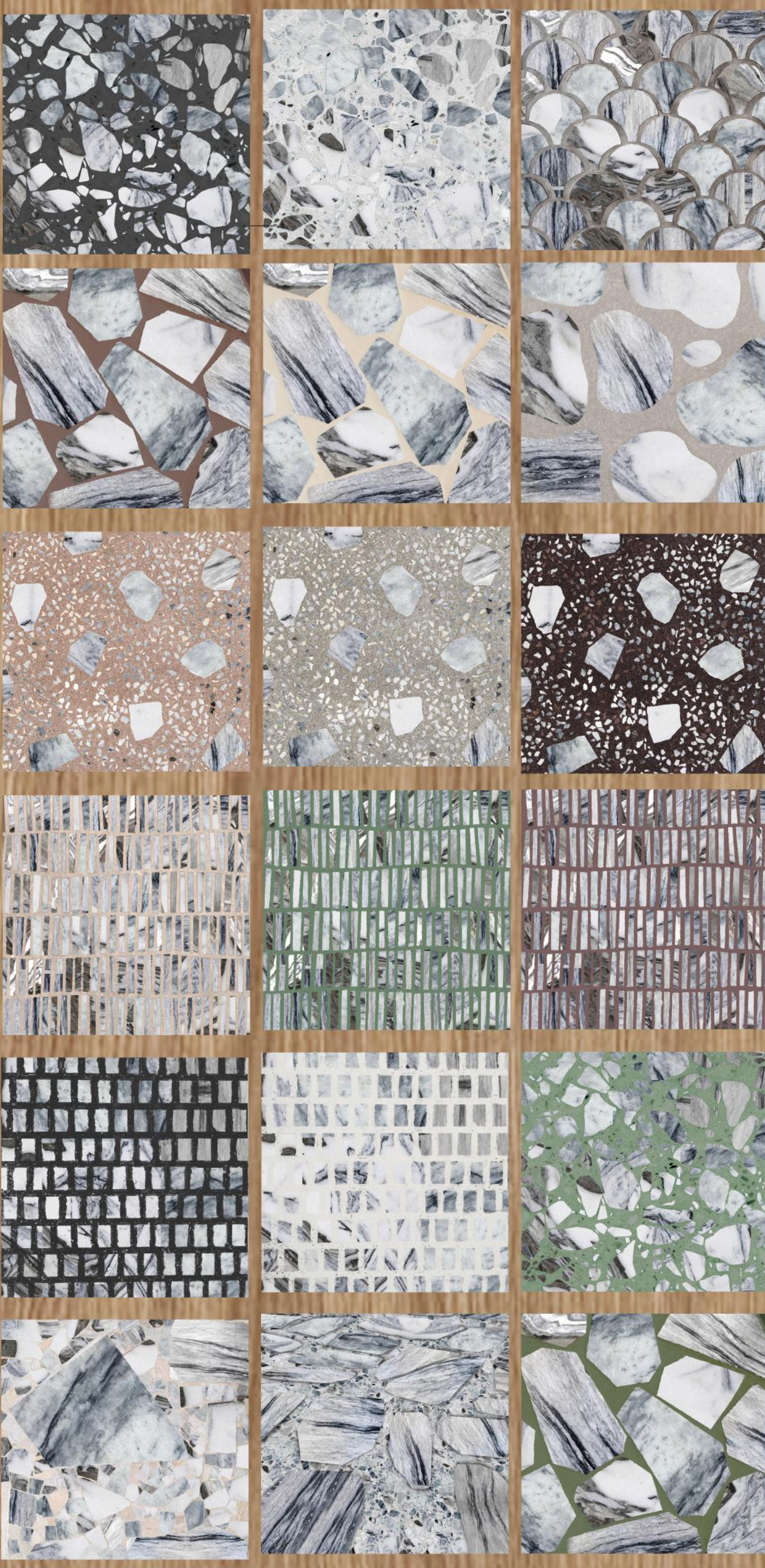




The paving beneath your feet is made from Greenland marble sourced from the closed quarry in Maarmoruk.



PROJECT STATEMENT
The project aims to show Greenland's Hardfisk Plads' cultural history with a broader audience through social and material-driven interventions.
By transforming the site into a public space that celebrates hardfisk culture, the project hopes to reveal its historical significance and foster awareness and discussion about Greenland's colonial history.
The site's identity is redefined by utilizing the power of Greenlandic media, emphasizing its visual culture and cultural symbolism. This once-overlooked material is being allowed to re-emerge in progress, both into the ground where it was once buried under, as well as into the Danish awareness.
