

The questionnaire is in Faroese and I have translated the questions to English for this booklet. This questionnaire has only been sent to people over 18 years old living in The Faroe Islands.



# What type of housing do you live in?





## If you live at home with family, why do you live at home?









# Do you think it will be difficult for you to find adequate housing when you move back to The Faroe Islands?











## Whom would you like in your cohousing community?








